



Studio Policies, Tuition, Membership fees, & Costume Fees

<u>Withdrawal Policy</u>- When enrolling in classes at STG, you are signing up for the entire year (September 3rd-June 11th). If you would like to withdraw from classes, you must notify the office no less than 30 days before the next billing cycle. For example, if your child will be done at the end of February, we need to know BEFORE February 1st so you are not charged tuition in March.

<u>Weather Closures</u>- STG makes every effort to remain open during inclement weather, but we will not put our families or staff at risk in dangerous conditions. We update our Instagram and Facebook pages with any closures, contact the local news stations, and send emails to all families. If we close for bad weather more than TWICE, we will begin offering make-up sessions. Refunds will not be offered for weather closures.

<u>Absence Policy</u>- STG does not offer refunds for any classes missed by your student for vacations, illnesses, or calendar conflicts. We allow students to attend TWO make-up classes in an equal level if they are absent twice. No make-up classes are offered beyond that. If there are injuries or other extenuating circumstances, we will will evaluate those on a case-by-case basis. *If a teacher is absent, and a substitute can't be found, we will offer a make-up session for the missed class.*

<u>Membership Fee</u>- A yearly STG Membership Fee is charged upon enrollment, along with your first month of tuition. The fee for returning dancers is \$35.00, and new dancers are \$45.00. Families do not have to pay membership fees for any children beyond the second one.

<u>Tuition Payments</u>-Steps to Grace classes each have a yearly course fee, and that fee is broken into ten equal monthly payments, the last of which is withdrawn on **June 1st**. Tuition is collected automatically on the 1st of each month. A credit or debit card must be on file for monthly autopayments. No exceptions. We do not charge credit card fees.

<u>Tuition Discounts</u>- 5% discounts are offered to first responders, church workers, and members of the military. We also offer sibling discounts of 5% for the second child and beyond. STG offers scholarships and tuition assistance on an as-needed basis. Please contact the office at kelly.stepstograce@gmail.com to have your discount applied, or to discuss our scholarship options. Discounts can't be combined.

Costume Fees

Costume Fees- Costumes are purchased for ALL dancers for the spring recital, with the exception of Mommy & Me classes. Costume fees will be auto-collected in installments to make it easier for our families. Costume fees are **NON-REFUNDABLE**, no exceptions.

The first installment of costume payments will auto-process for most classes on October 15, 2024. The second installment will be processed for most classes on January 15, 2025. See fee schedule below.

If your class only requires ONE payment, it will be auto-processed on October 15, 2024. If your dancer enrolls AFTER January 15, 2025, their entire costume payment will be due upon enrollment.

Frequently asked questions

When is the first day of class? When is the last day of class? When is the studio closed for holidays?

Classes begin September 3, 2024 and end on June 11th, 2025. STG is closed on Labor Day and Memorial Day. Make-up classes for those holidays will be offered to our Monday students on June 16 & 23, 2025. Classes will take place at their regularly scheduled times .Please check the STG academic calendar for more important dates and holidays. STG is closed 3/23-3/29 for Spring Break, and 12/21-1/11 for Christmas..

When is recital?

Winter recital is on Saturday, December 14, 2024. Times will be announced at a later date. Spring recital is on Saturday, June 14, 2025. Times will be announced at a later date, but we will have shows going ALL DAY. Dress rehearsals will be on December 13th for winter shows, and on June 12th and 13th for the spring shows. Times TBA.

What do you do with my STG Membership fee?

Membership fees hold your place in class, and are used to pay for our studio's insurance policies each year, as well as administrative costs incurred during our busy registration season.

How do I watch my child while they are in class?

We have large video monitors for each classroom in our lobby, and each room has a window available for viewing.

Tell me all about costumes!

Bring on the glitter! Professional costumes are ordered throughout the year for dancers to wear in our JUNE recital. and we stick to simple outfits and accessories for our December show to keep costs down for our families. Students are measured by Steps to Grace staff members during every class, and costumes are ordered based on those measurements. Costume payment schedules can be found on our "policies" page above, and those fees are auto-debited on the due date. ALL enrolled students will participate in both recitals, with the exception of Mommy & Me classes. *Costume fees are non-refundable. Costume suppliers universally do not offer refunds, therefore we are unable to give refunds to our families once costume fees have been paid.*

Why is full tuition charged for December, March, & June, even though classes don't run the entire month? Steps to Grace classes are all offered with a yearly "course fee". Our course fees are split into ten equal monthly payments, the last of which is auto-debited on **June 1st**.
